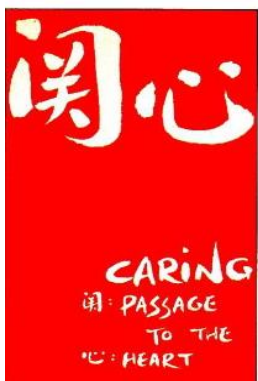

Why: You are a caring nurse/health care provider or caregiver who wants to become a stronger leader to help restore the ethic of caring in health care systems and transform systems to caring healing cultures. Take the next step that will change your life and the systems all around you. Watson Caring Science Institute (WCSI) is the international, nonprofit organization founded by Dr. Jean Watson in 2007 to advance the philosophies, theories, and practices of Human Caring. WCSI's Caritas Coach Education Program (CCEP) can prepare, inspire, and empower you to be that Nurse/Caregiver-Caritas-Coach-change-agent in your system. Who: The CCEP is for any nurse or caregiver—clinician, administrator, educator, or leader—who wants to learn more about implementing compassionate Caring Practices that honor relationship and wholeness of each person.

What: The CCEP's intentional outcome is to transform nursing and organizational cultures

through modeling and living out Caring for self, practitioners, staff, and all people cared for.

How: The Caritas Coach Program is a unique, six-month educational program that offers 58 contact hours. Structured as an experiential, aesthetic and intellectual journey, the CCEP combines six months of on-line faculty-mentor-guided study with required attendance at two 4-day on-site events six months apart. Each of the two on-site events includes a 2-day International Caritas Consortium (ICC) meeting (separate registration), immediately followed by CCEP evening reception, plus 2-day on-site educational seminar. Participants will learn how to translate Caring Science into authentic practice of Caritas-Ways-of-Being/Doing in caring for self and others. Innovative methodologies, dialogue, 'teachings' and wisdom traditions will be explored to assist the participants in living out Heart-Centered-Caritas-Relation-Modeling-Practices for self, other, and systems. Individual personal/ professional life-goals will be honored through the collective and shared journey of the Caritas Coaching experience.
