Established August 29, 2007, Watson Caring Science Institute (WCSI) is an international non-profit 501C(3) organization that advances the unitary philosophies, theories and practices of Caring Science, developed by Dr. Jean Watson, Ph.D., RN, AHN-BC, FAAN, LL (AAN). Watson's Caring Science is a trans-disciplinary approach that incorporates the art and science of nursing and includes concepts from the fields of philosophy, ethics, ecology and mind-body-spirit medicine.

Our work has proven to engage and retain nursing staff and dramatically improve patient's perception of care. Focusing on research, education, practice, legacy and leadership, WCSI deepens the development and understanding of Caring Science and Caritas Practices. As a result, we intentionally transform the patient/family experiences of caring and healing in schools, hospitals, the wider community and our planet.

What is Watson's Caring Science?

Watson's Caring Science expands and deepens the conventional model of medical science, offering a unitary world view of connectedness of all. Watson's Caring Science theory has codified the universals of human caring, transcending language, religion and borders. Those universals are identified and manifested through the 10 Caritas Processes®.

We're here for nurses...

First and foremost, Caring Science incorporates the ethic of caring which expands the medical technical model of science. This theory was developed by a nruse, for nurses and all caring professionals; and while our first responsibility is to uphold and uplift the discipline and profession of nursing, it goes beyond nursing. Nurses and human caring are critically important to the health and healing for humanity and the planet. We do this because as our Fonder Jean Watson reminds us "nursing in the paradigm exemplar of human caring, the most mature healing profession in the world."

Mission

- To restore the profound nature of caring-healing within a Caring Science framework in stewardship to the current healthcare system worldwide.
- To retain and nurture its most precious resource, caring professional nurses and trans-disciplinary care team members.
- To deepen and expand Watson's Caring Science, the philosophies, theories, ethics and practices of Human Caring, originated by Founder/Director Jean Watson.

Goals & Objectives

- Transform the dominant model of medical science to a model of Watson's Caring Science by reintroducing the ethic, philosophy and diverse practices of caring and Love (Caritas), necessary for healing.
- Deepen the authentic Caring-Healing relationships between caregiver and patient/family, to restore Love and compassion as the ethical, values foundation of healthcare.
- Translate the model of Caring-Healing/Caritas into fully integrated transdisciplinary programs and services to help transform healthcare one nurse / one caregiver / one educator / one leader / one system at a time.
- Ensure caring and healing for the public, improve nurse and care provider retention in healthcare settings, enhance patient care outcomes, promote safe practices, and decrease costs to the system.

TEN CARITAS PROCESSES®



1. Embrace (Loving-Kindness)

Sustaining humanistic-altruistic values by practice of loving-kindness, compassion and equanimity with self and others.

2. Inspire (Faith-Hope)

Being authentically present, enabling a system of faith, hope and belief, honoring the subjective inner life-world of self and others.

3. Trust (Transpersonal)

Being sensitive to self and others by cultivating one's own spiritual practices, beyond ego-self to transpersonal presence.

4. Nurture (Relationship)

Developing and sustaining loving, trusting-caring relationships.

5. Forgive (Holding Space)

Allowing for expression of positive and negative feelings — authentically listening to another person's story.

6. Deepen (Creative Self)

Creatively problem-solving-solution-seeking through the caring process, with full use of self and artistry of caring-healing practices via all ways of knowing / being / doing / becoming.

7. Balance (Learning)

Engaging in transpersonal teaching and learning within the context of a caring relationship. Staying within another's frame of reference and shifting toward a coaching model for expanded health and wellness.

8. Co-create (Caritas Field)

Creating a subtle healing environment at all levels for an energetic, authentic caring presence.

9. Minister (Humanity)

Reverentially assisting with basic needs as sacred acts, touching mind / body / spirit of another, sustaining human dignity.

10. Open (Infinity)

Opening to spiritual, mystery and unknowns — allowing for miracles.
