
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THE 10 CARITAS PROCESSES®

Watson's Caring Science Theory has codified the universals of human caring, transcending language, religion, and borders: those universals are identified and named, manifested or 'lived out' through the 10 Caritas Processes®. They are 10 universal truths or canons in which to live and work by.

- 1. EMBRACE altruistic values and practice of loving-kindness, compassion and equanimity with self and others.
- 2. INSPIRE Being authentically present, enabling faith/hope/belief system, honoring subjective inner, lifeworld of self/others.
- 3. TRUST Being sensitive to self and others by cultivating own spiritual practices; beyond ego-self to transpersonal presence.
- 4. NURTURE Developing and sustaining loving, trusting-caring relationships.
- 5. FORGIVE Allowing for expression of positive and negative feelings authentically listening to another person's story.
- 6. DEEPEN Creatively problem-solving, solution—seeking through a caring process; full use of self and artistry of caring-healing practices via use of all ways of knowing/being/doing/becoming.
- 7. BALANCE Engaging in transpersonal teaching and learning within context of caring relationship; staying within other's frame of reference-shift toward coaching model for expanded health/wellness.
- 8. CO-CREATE Creating a healing environment at all levels; subtle environment for energetic authentic caring presence.
- 9. MINSTER Reverentially assisting with basic needs as sacred acts, touching mindbodyspirit of other; sustaining human dignity.
- 10. OPEN Opening to spiritual, mystery, unknowns allowing for miracles.

To become a Watson Caring Science Affiliate, an organization must demonstrate a sustainable commitment to integrate the values, philosophy, and theory of Watson's Caring Science. WCSI will offer ongoing support and resources, including customized training programs and consulting, with priority access to Dr. Watson, WCSI Faculty, experts, and scholars. This supports transformation to embed a caring-healing culture.

Watson Caring Science Affiliate / Distinguished Affiliate

We have identified **two levels** of designation: **Affiliate**, and **Distinguished Affiliate**. Both levels showcase and celebrate a commitment to Watson's Caring Science, to broaden a caring healing environment for staff, patients and families, organizational culture, and communities.

- **Affiliation** demonstrating the required indicators
- Distinguished Affiliation for more advanced organizations; demonstrating required plus additional exemplary indicators.

Both Affiliate & Distinguished Affiliate organizations will demonstrate commitment to Watson's Caring Science using the indicators described under four categories: Legacy/Leadership, Education, Praxis & Research. Affiliate leaders are encouraged to disseminate their Watson Caring Science practice model and outcomes through scholarly publications, research, and international workshops and conferences, thereby contributing to the nursing field.

Watson Caring Science Affiliate Required Indicators

To apply, please use the following required indicators to guide your application for affiliate success. These have been created to help you identify authentic practices of Watson's Caring Science theory and 'living out' the 10 Caritas Processes.® Required indicators are grouped under: Legacy/ Leadership; Education; Praxis, and Research. Please provide an example addressing each bullet point.

Legacy/Leadership

Sustaining the healing environment culture of caring for staff, colleagues, patients and their family, and communities.

- Evidence of alignment of organization mission, vision, values with Watson Caring Science (WCS) philosophy and theory
- A minimum of 2 Caritas Coaches®, Caritas Leader® (completed, currently enrolled, or accepted onto program) or other Caring Science Scholar/Champion appointed within your system
- Evidence of budget/time allocation for staff attendance in integrated medicine/WCSI programs to support ongoing human caring culture
- Presence of Watson's Caring Science branding, logos, and language to promote a whole system consciousness and intentionality

Education

Evidence of Watson Caring Science theory, values and philosophy in learning/teaching methodologies

- Design or provide examples of Watson's Caring Science curricula and pedagogies in professional development and training programs
- Visible evidence of caring language, art, and artistry for staff, colleagues, and communities in professional development led by Caritas Coaches®
- Evidence of staff attendance/participation at WCSI presentations, programs, workshops

Praxis

Exemplary practice of informed loving kindness using Watson Caring Science theory, values, morals, and philosophy

- Evidence of one or more example how Caritas Processes® is utilized as a theoretical philosophical guide to patient family care
- Evidence of caring-healing modalities that promote healing and self-care for staff or patients/clients (e.g. intentional touch, reflexology, music, aromatherapy, sound, visualization, imagery, and relaxation, etc.)
- Presence of staff wellness and self-care options that align with Watson's Caring Science theory (e.g. 'Watson Rooms' healing space, sanctuaries, quiet spaces for staff renewal)
- Visible evidence of Staff Caritas Practices that celebrates and honors their uniqueness such as through language, art, artistry

Research/Inquiry

Participation in Clinical Caring Scholarship

- Use of Watson's Caring Science theory and framework to guide scholarship and research
- Conduct or participate in research projects with WCSI (e.g. Caritas Coach®; Caritas Nurse®/Partner™ projects)



Distinguished Affiliate Recognition

Watson Caring Science Affiliates who have met the required indicators may submit **additional examples** to be recognized as a Distinguished Caring Science Affiliate. Please choose one or more from each category.

Legacy/Leadership

- Joint collaboration with WCSI on grants/funding opportunities for program development
- Disseminate the return on investment, value and metrics of Watson's Caring Science as professional practice model with peers and colleagues

Education

- Evidence of progression routes for staff to develop their caring science knowledge and integration (e.g. Caritas Coaches® become Caritas Leaders® or mentor colleagues/ share integrated medicine modalities with others)
- Co-create new innovative programs to authentically advance Watson's Caring Science within the organizational culture (e.g. Caritas Nurse[®], Caritas Partner[™])

Praxis

- Documentation of patient/nursing caritas moments in medical health records
- Identify and share patient stories of exceptional caring (e.g., Lotus Recognition™, DAISY Awards, case studies etc.)
- Advance Watson's Caring Science as an interdisciplinary practice model with peers
- Organization encourages and values staff to advance their expertise in Watson's Caring Science and /or healing modalities (e.g., integrative nursing such as Healing Touch, reiki, aromatherapy, etc.)

Research/Inquiry

- Evidence of staff presentation of Watson's Caring Science scholarship/research through publications, speaking engagements and workshops
- Participation in clinical caring research and scholarship to assess outcomes of the patient care experience (e.g. Watson Caritas Measures®)
