The Santa Clara Caritas in Action Council has been active for over 10 years. This dedicated team of nurses aims to promote Caring Science in the different nursing units by providing opportunities for frontline nurses to engage in self-care and caring acts for others. They utilize the <a href="total">10 Caritas</a> <a href="Processes">Processes</a>® as a framework for their projects and activities.

One of their activities was their Elf on the Shelf, a Holiday Elf-in Challenge. Every day, staff nurses were challenged to take a photo of the "naughty elf on the shelf" embodying a Caritas Process. Not only did this activity spark joy and laughter, but it also allowed staff to implement the different Caritas Processes in their day-to-day work and activities.

There were 22 entries across multiple departments. This activity encouraged collaboration, creative expression, teamwork, camaraderie and celebrated acts of kindness throughout the hospital, thus creating an environment of caring.
