“HUMANIZING NURSING EDUCATION”

“For nursing students, who enter educational programs primarily to care for others, uncaring encounters may be extremely detrimental for them as individuals.... If nursing education programs do not fundamentally aspire to actualizing caring encounters, learning may be sabotaged, leading to inappropriate and/or a lack of understanding of the importance of caring as the foundation of nursing” (Adam and Maykut, 2015, p. 768)

Dr. Chantal Cara is a full professor at the Université de Montréal in Quebec, Canada. She earned her Ph.D. from the University of Colorado under the directorship of Dr. Jean Watson. She is also a researcher at the Montreal’s Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in Rehabilitation and at the Quebec Network on Nursing Intervention Research for humanistic practices. Renowned bilingual expert in the field of Human Caring, she is a Visiting Caring Science Scholar/Professor at the University of Colorado and at the Haute École La Source in Switzerland. For 30 years, Dr. Cara has been actively involved in the advancement of Human Caring in both French and English communities. She recently published her new book with Dr. Jean Watson and Dr. Marcia Hills “An Educator’s Guide to Humanizing Nursing Education”
